The Educational Facilitator and Program Coordinator will be involved in the larger organizational life of Achvat Amim and its strategic development. This is a great opportunity for someone who is passionate about critical education, group facilitation, and solidarity organizing.

About Solidarity of Nations - Achvat Amim:

Since 2013 Achvat Amim has worked to bring international communities into the movement for peace, justice, and equality between Israelis and Palestinians. We bring five-month cohorts of international justice seekers to live communally in the heart of Jerusalem, participate in a critical and democratic educational process, and volunteer with prominent human rights and shared society organizations. We are committed to resourcing our communities with the practical skills, analytic frameworks, and cross-community relationships they need to function as sustained actors within broader democratic movements and advocacy initiatives.

About the Post:

We are looking to recruit an Educational Facilitator and Program Coordinator to join our dynamic team. This individual will function as the primary program facilitator responsible for overseeing the general operation of our educational and cohort processes as central components of our work and movement building.

The individual will work as part of a three person leadership team directing the organizational life of Achvat Amim, and will be present for all internal organizational processes and partnership-building activities as appropriate to that task. They will work closely with other staff, organizational partners, and program participants to advance Achvat Amim's mission of peace, justice, and self-determination for all.

Direct Educational Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Oversee the programmatic and logistical operation of a half year experiential learning program for internationals in Jerusalem.· Design, coordinate, and facilitate comprehensive educational curricula related to community life, justice struggles, and power relations in the region.· Co-vision, coordinate, and facilitate learning days with cohort members in a participatory learning process.
Manage Volunteer Placements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Coordinate volunteer placements for participants with human rights organizations, shared society initiatives, and community empowerment organizations in the region.· Manage relationships and organizational partnerships with placement sites and contacts.· Facilitate participants through their placement experiences and be available for support.

- Ability to work well in a diverse team, as well as with a wide range of volunteers, activists, and partners.
